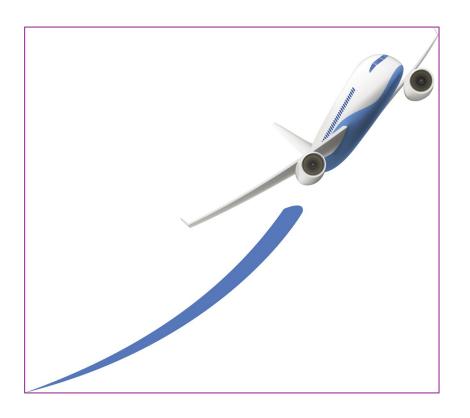
Methodology

An online flash poll was conducted of GBTA members and non-members worldwide, including corporate travel managers and travel suppliers

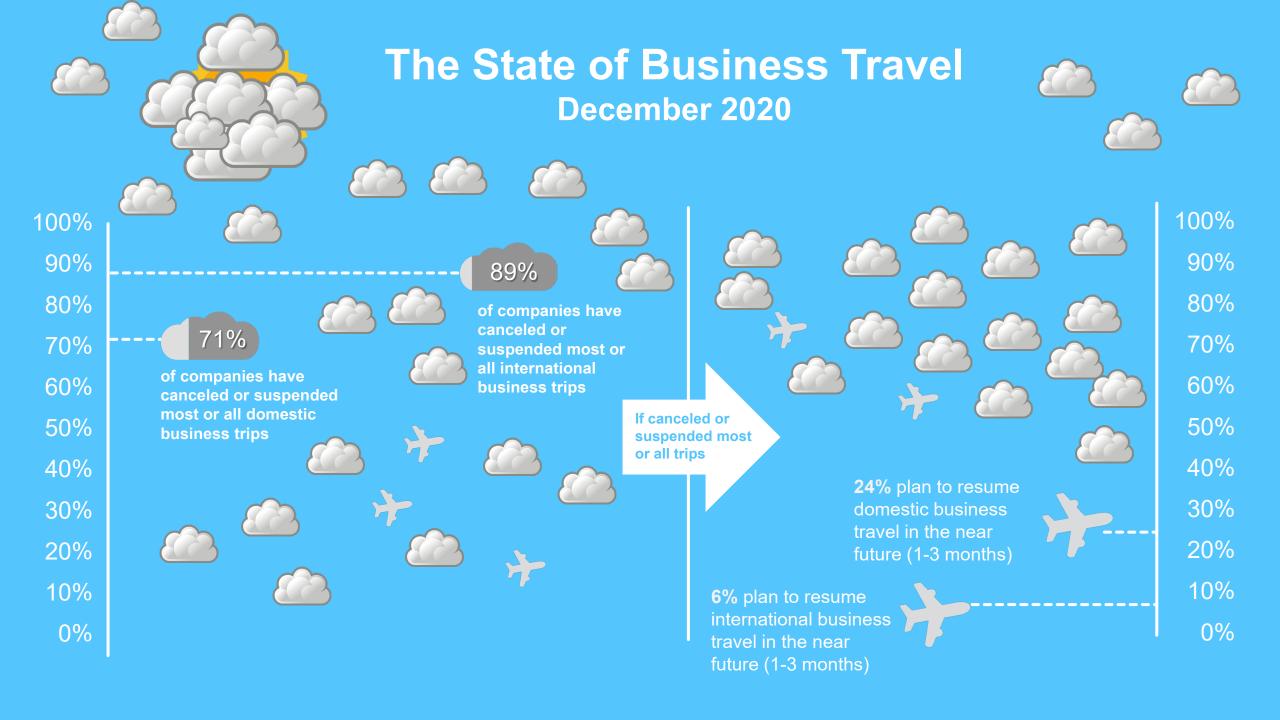
- Fielding took place from December 7 through December 14, 2020
- An email invitation was sent to 16,269 travel professionals including current and inactive members of GBTA; a link to the survey was also included in GBTA's *Daily News Brief* sent to travel professionals worldwide
- In total, 760 companies responded to the poll
- Note: Some totals might not add to 100% because of rounding; each percentage is rounded to the nearest whole number

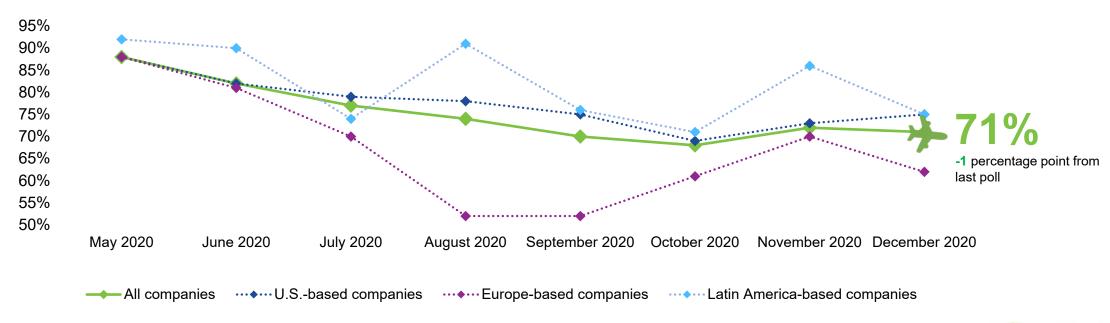






The State of Domestic Business Travel

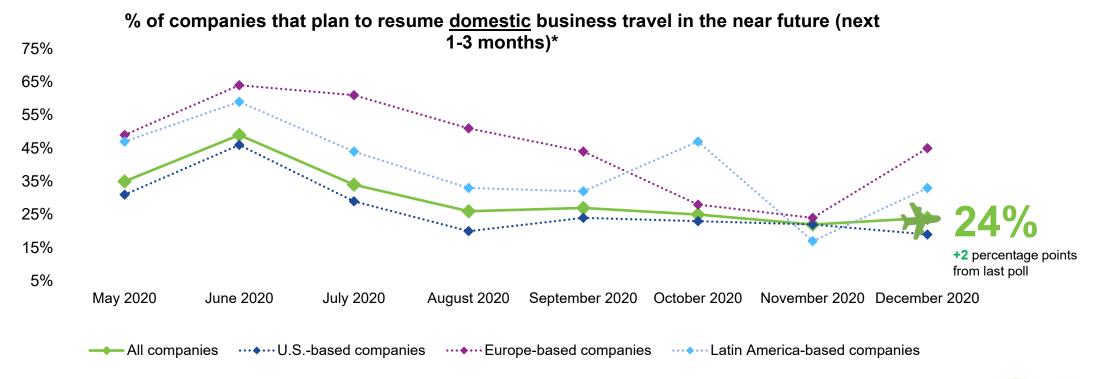
% of companies that have canceled or suspended most or all <u>domestic</u> business travel within their country

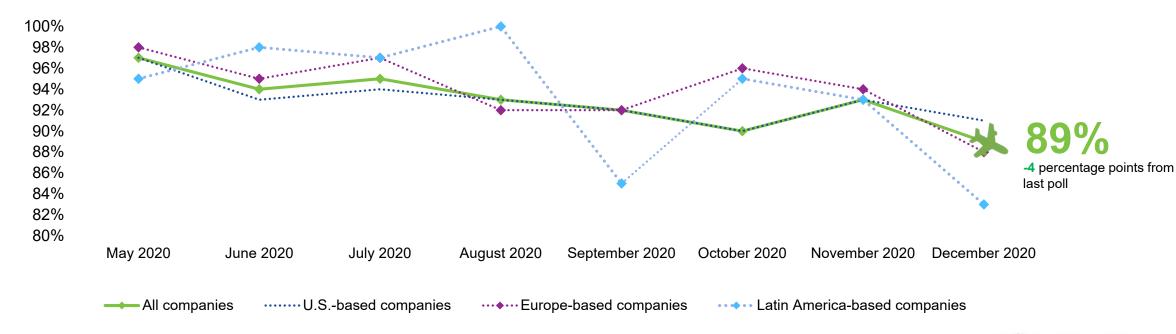

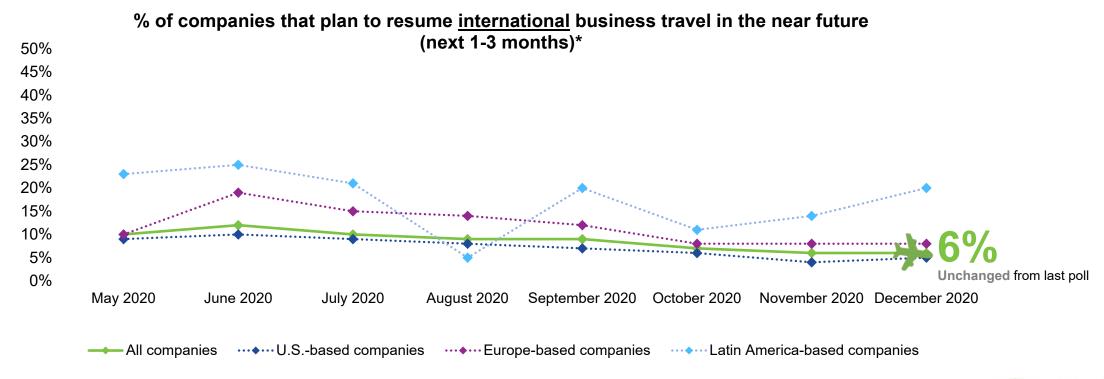
The State of International Business Travel

% of companies that have canceled or suspended most or all international business travel





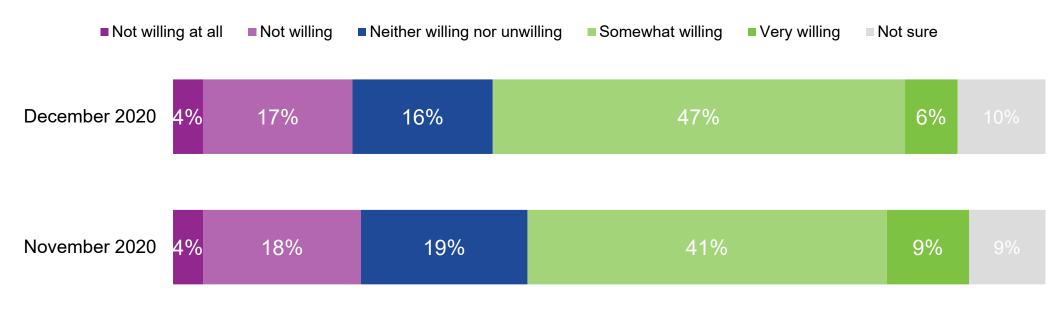

Do Travel Managers think their company's employees are willing to travel?

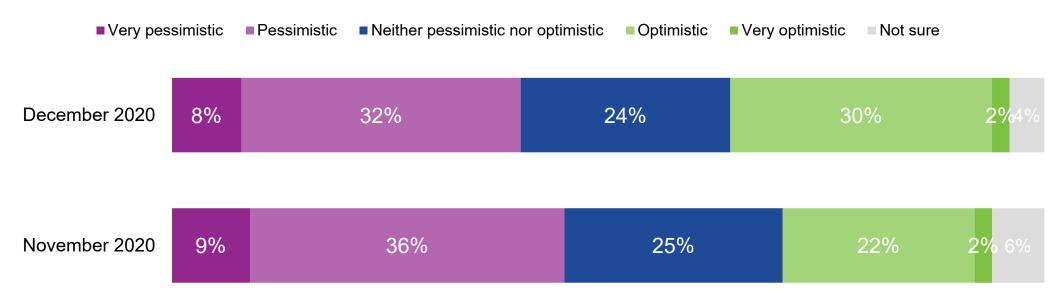

Average percentage of travel spend respondents expect their company will allocate to different purposes in 2021

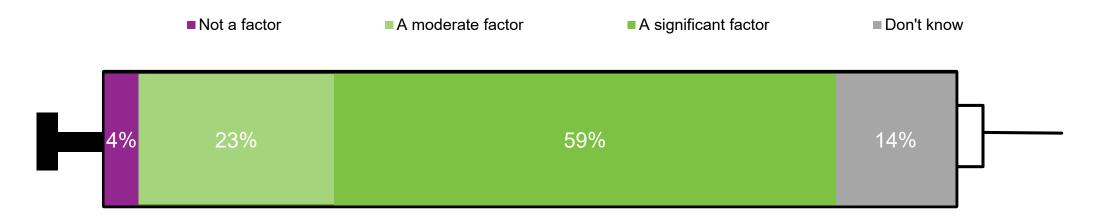

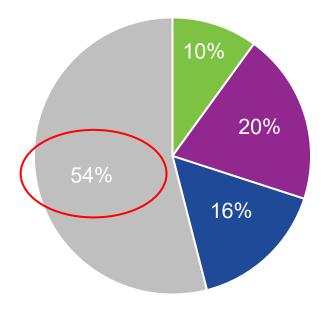
To what extent will the availability of vaccines factor into your company's decision to resume business travel?

How will vaccines influence decision to resume business travel?



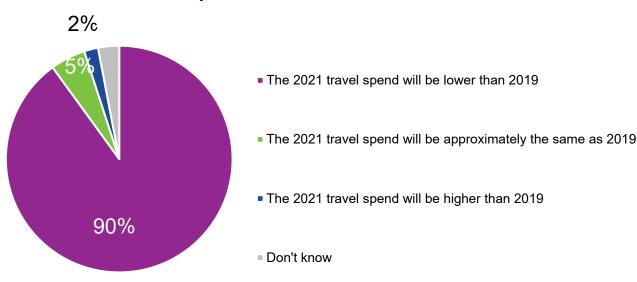
- Employees will be permitted to travel for work when they have been vaccinated

of companies have canceled or suspended **most** (27%) or **all** (61%) trips to Latin America



88%

of companies have canceled or suspended **most** (39%) or **all** (49%) trips to European countries



87%

of companies have canceled or suspended **most** (30%) or **all** (57%) trips to Canada



76%

of companies have canceled or suspended **most** (45%) or **all** (31%) trips to the United States

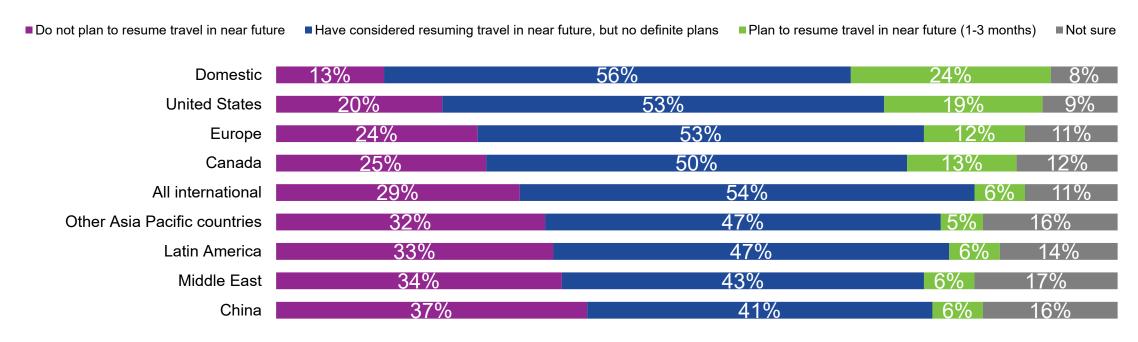
